LYCON strip-less hot waxes are the absolute best to use on sensitive areas such as the face, eyebrows, underarms and the intimate zone, as they are extra gentle and efficient! LYCON hot waxes are a comfortable temperature, while they dilate the follicles, allowing hairs to be removed more easily. LYCON Hot Waxes can remove hair as short as 1mm & can be reapplied to the same area 5-6 times without irritation or discomfort. It is important to always use LYCON Pre-Waxing Oil before hot wax application and re-applications on the same area. For the best and easiest virtually pain free waxing, it is best to remove LYCON hot waxes when they are still soft and pliable.

LYCON TRADITIONAL HOT WAXES

They stem from LYCON's unique original hot wax formula, while each has its individual addition of special essential oils that makes them extra gentle on even the most sensitive skins. LYCON Traditional Hot Waxes come in gel type hot waxes and others are opaque as they contain soothing and calming Titanium Dioxide, which provides extra pliability and comfort on delicate areas. For the best and easiest virtually pain free waxing, it is best to remove LYCON hot waxes when they are still soft and pliable.

LYCOJET

LYCON Lycojet is a unique strip-less hot wax, which is used like a hot wax, but applied thinner. Lycojet is excellent for all waxing and is extremely strong while it gently removes short stubborn hairs, as well as fluffy fine hairs that other waxes can miss. With Lycojet the Super Hero hot wax, you can eliminate the need to tweeze at the end of waxing. It is excellent for the face, underarms, intimate waxing and to remove short stubborn hairs that strip wax may at times miss.

LYCOTEC FILM WAX

This high-tec formula with new generation synthetic resins and Titanium Dioxide make LYCOtec super smooth and ultra-pliable. Scented with either coconut or berries, these waxes are extremely easy to apply and come off the skin without breaking. LYCOtec glides on skin super thinly, making it efficient, extra economical for salons and ideal for delicate areas including Brazilians. "Vegan friendly".

LYCODREAM HYBRID HOT WAX

LYCODream is a precise balance between LYCON's legendary Hot Wax & LYCOtec film wax formulas. It offers the superior grip of LYCON Hot Wax, removing hair as short as 1mm, plus the pliability and ease of use of LYCOtec. Extra gentle and extra strong, simply the best of both worlds at your fingertips!

STRIP WAX

Excellent, fast and economical for large areas: legs, arms, chests, backs or buttocks. LYCON Strip Waxes are gentle as they are not sticky and leave no sticky residue. NOTE: LYCON Hot Waxes are recommended for Brazilians, as they remove hair as short as 1mm and are more gentle on sensitive and more delicate areas.

LYCON STRIP WAX KEY INGREDIENTS

- Superior pine and synthetic rosins - for the best grip on relatively short hairs
- Vegetable Oil
- Sweet Almond Oil
- Essential oils – soothing and calming
- Titanium Dioxide – makes strip wax smooth and gentle and even less sticky

WAX HEATING TO WORKING TEMPERATURES

Melt hot wax completely in a wax heater at about 130°C, then let wax cool to a working consistency. Alternatively, melt half the wax that is in a heater, then turn the heater down to its working temperature and allow the melted wax to melt the remaining un-melted wax, stirring occasionally. LYCON Hot Wax working temperature is when it is like a thick honey consistency. LYCON Strip Wax is used in a more runny consistency than hot wax.

Hot Wax – 60°C

Strip Wax – 78°C

NOTE: Wax Heater settings can vary from brand to brand. It is important to have a suitable wax thermometer to test the wax temperature, until you become familiar with the right working temperature and consistency. It is also extremely important to test the wax for a comfortable working temperature on yourself before applying to client's skin. For extra care and safety, you must check with the client if the wax is comfortable on them before you continue to wax, as temperature tolerance can differ from person to person.

LYCOTIP

Before waxing a client, apply wax on your inner wrist with a wooden spatula, to ensure it is a comfortable working temperature.

PRE AND POST WAXING PRODUCTS

It is important to use the recommended LYCON pre and post waxing lotions during all waxing treatments, as they provide a more hygienic and comfortable waxing experience. Below is an overview of the Pre & Post products used in Eyebrow waxing.

CONTRA-INDICATIONS TO WAXING

The following are conditions you need to identify before a waxing treatment. You need to use your own good judgement, as there are various levels of severity in each condition.

- Varicose veins - do not wax over moderate or well-pronounced varicose veins.
- Bruises - do not wax over bruises, until they subside.
- Skin diseases e.g. herpes - do not wax near herpes or cold sores.
- Defective Circulation e.g. ulcers on the legs - do not wax over these.
- Cuts, abrasions, scabs - do not wax over any of these, unless they are well healed.
- Warts - do not wax over warts.
- Hairy moles - do not wax hair from hairy moles. Simply cut the hair off at skin level before waxing, then wax the surrounding area.
- Sunburn or windburn - do not wax over these conditions until the skin is well healed.
- Recent scars - only wax after scars have healed well.
- Irritated or inflamed skin - do not wax over these conditions.
- Rashes or infection - do not wax over these conditions.
- Cancer or Chemotherapy patients – Not to be waxed, unless you have a doctors certificate that you can wax them.
- Customers on Roaccutane or Retin A - You can use LYCON hot waxes, providing the skin is not inflamed, peeling or flaky. Never use strip wax on these clients! Make sure to use LYCON Pre-Waxing Oil before hot wax application and to also reapply LYCON Pre-Waxing oil before each hot wax reapplication.

The client's follicles are open after waxing. It is important to offer clients suitable post waxing care advice to help avoid irritation or infection.

- Do not go swimming until redness subsides.
- Do not have a hot shower or bath until redness subsides.
- Do not use a solarium or sunbake until redness subsides.
- Do not apply self-tanning products until redness subsides.
- Do not exfoliate the area for 3 days after waxing.

HYGIENE

It is important to offer a hygienic and professional salon treatment to minimise the possible risk of infection. It is also important to know your local Government Health Department regulations in relation to professional waxing services and what the local regulations are. In relation to waxing, we do not re-dip our spatulas or recycle used wax. Also suitable gloves must be worn during waxing treatments on the body.

It is imperative to keep all appliances, implements, instruments and tools in a clean condition. Instruments and tools must be disinfected before use and immediately after use on each client.

CLEANLINESS

As a waxing specialist it is your duty to provide a hygienic, clean working environment to protect yourself and your clients against potential cross infection. We suggest you use this checklist to ensure you are providing safe waxing procedures and a hygienic environment.

Assess all clients prior to the waxing treatment:

- Is your client taking any form of medication?
- Has your client been in the sun or used a sun bed over the last few days?
- Does your client have any open wounds, rashes or skin infections?
- Has the bed, trolley and all implements been sterilised?
- Is your wax heater clean?
- Is your wax at the correct working temperature?
- Have you washed your hands with an antiseptic wash?
- Do you have gloves on as required?
- Do you have disposable spatulas or sufficient metal spatulas?
- Do you have good lighting? A Maggi Lamp is advisable.
- Have you prepared the skin by cleansing with LYCON Lycotane Skin Cleanser before waxing?
- If using LYCON Hot Wax, have you applied a small amount of LYCON Pre-Waxing Oil to the skin before hot wax application? Do not forget to reapply Pre-Waxing Oil before subsequent wax applications!

HEALTH REGULATIONS

Different states interpret the OH&S standards differently, therefore the regulations may differ from state to state. The state regulations are then interpreted and enforced by the local city councils.


For other countries, make sure you are well informed of your local regulations.

EYEBROW SHAPING

The eyebrows not only frame the eyes, they are also an important part of our facial features and expressions. Eyebrows come in many shapes and hair growth patterns, which play a big part in the overall balance of the face. Some eyebrows can be unflattering for many reasons, however most can easily be reshaped for a more attractive outcome. Eyebrow sculpting is an art, which requires knowledge in how to offer the best professional services to your clients. You need to have good judgment and an eye for detail. In addition, it is important to use the right products, so you can achieve the very best results for your clients, which in return benefits your business and professional reputation.


Eyebrow shaping/sculpting can be a minimal treatment or it can be relatively involved and detailed. Depending on the client's eyebrow condition and personal preferences, you can wax under, in between or above the eyebrows. It is important to always have a consultation with your client before you wax to determine what would best suit them. It is imperative you explain exactly what you intend to do, how much hair you plan to remove, making sure they understand what you are explaining and have their approval. Some clients may have a scar in their eyebrow where hairs don't grow, which you will need to point out to them. This way they will not think you have removed hairs that were not there to begin with.

Before you apply wax, make sure to trim unruly hairs, to prevent accidentally catching hairs in the wax. Once waxing is completed, you may need to tweeze a few stray hairs off to create the best finish.




SHAPING

1. To determine where to remove hair from, align a pencil from the side of the nose to the inner corner of the eye. Hair growing between the eyebrows to these lines should be removed.
2. Then angle the pencil from the corner of the nose so that it passes across the outer edge of the iris. Where the pencil crosses the brow, should be the highest point (apex) of the brow.
3. Then place the pencil from the corner of the nose, to the outer corner of the eye. The spot where the pencil crosses the eyebrow, should be where the length of the eyebrow should finish.



4. When the eyebrows are too thin and highly arched, they give the face a surprised look that draws attention to the brows rather than to the entire face.
5. When brows are too widely spaced and slanted downward at the outer ends, it makes the eyes look like they have a vacant stare or appear sad and droopy.
6. When brows are too heavy and too close together, they give the impression of frowning or that the person is displeased.
7. The distance between normally set eyes is the width of one eye.
8. Close set eyes – Shape the eyebrows so that the distance between them equals the width of one eye. Start the eyebrow over the tear duct rather than over the corner of the eye.
9. Wide set eyes – They will look closer together if the eyebrows are shaped to have the distance of an eye span between them.
10. Some people have eyebrows that grow downwards or upwards in parts. Before wax application, it is important to trim any upwards or downwards growing hairs with small scissors along the actual eyebrow line to avoid removing hairs you don't intend to remove when you apply the wax.



By following these guidelines you can correct poorly shaped brows, lift and re-shape the brows to better suit the client's face and to create a better balance of their facial features and improve their appearance.

An added bonus is that well shaped eyebrows are a quick and highly effective anti-ageing treatment. With well shaped eyebrows, you can make the whole face look younger and fresher, taking years off in minutes!


EYEBROW WAXING

LYCON recommends hot wax for eyebrows and all face waxing. For eyebrow waxing on normal skin we recommend using LYCON LYCOJET EyeBrow Hot Wax formulated with Calendula and Chamomile! It is very gentle while removing both strong and fluffy, fine hairs. If your client is extra sensitive, it is best to use a LYCON Hot Wax that contains Titanium Dioxide, such as Rosette, Lycoflex or SoBerry Delicious Hot Wax.

EYEBROW WAXING PROCEDURE

There are many different spatulas for eyebrow waxing. A good and easy eyebrow waxing spatula is the slanted end of the LYCON Precise shaping spatulas (similar to a cuticle stick).

1. Firstly, brush the hairs upwards and downwards and trim any out of place hairs with LYCON eyebrow scissors. This will ensure you do not wax hairs off that should not be removed.
2. Cleanse the skin with Lycotane Skin Cleanser.
3. Apply a very light film of LYCON Pre-Waxing Oil and lightly massage it into the skin. The skin needs to feel only slightly oily. If too much oil is applied, the wax will not stick to the hairs. Simply tissue excess oil off.
NOTE: It is important to always reapply LYCON Pre-Waxing Oil before each wax application and re-application.
4. Between the eyebrows, apply wax with the hair growth for the first two applications, ensuring the wax application is symmetrical. (Diagram a)
5. Remove wax downwards, against the hair growth.
6. Further wax applications need to be applied against the hair growth, so you can catch short stubborn hairs.
7. Underneath the eyebrows, apply wax with the hair growth with good pressure for the first two applications (Diagram b). While wax is setting on one side, apply wax to the other side. It is best to apply further applications against the hair growth and with good pressure, so short hairs will be lifted into the wax.
8. Remove the wax against the hair growth, while you support the skin opposite to the pull with the other hand. Skin support is essential in order to prevent skin drag. As soon as a wax patch is removed, soothe the waxed area



by applying gentle pressure with your fingers.

9. Above the eyebrows, apply wax in the direction of hair growth (Diagram c), with firm pressure. While wax is setting on one side, apply the wax on the other side.
10. Support the skin well with one hand and remove the wax against the hair growth with the other hand.
11. Apply pressure on the skin, as soon as you have removed a wax patch.
12. If you didn't need to trim the hairs before an eyebrow wax, you may need to give them a slight trim at the end. To do this, brush the hairs upwards and downwards, to work out if you need to trim them. If necessary trim the ends carefully, making sure not to trim too much length off.
13. Older clients may have some long unruly hairs amongst their eyebrows. Those are best tweezed off, which generally does not make a difference to the eyebrow shape. If you feel the shape or thickness will be affected, you can trim the long odd hairs, however trimming is not advisable, as they are usually strong and spikey. It is generally best to remove the entire hair.
14. When complete, wipe over the waxed area with Lycotane on a cotton pad.
15. If the client is prone to ingrown hairs, apply Ingrown-X-it Solution on a cotton pad, making sure it doesn't come in contact with the eyes.
16. To finish, apply Tea-Tree Soothe cream.

EYEBROW & EYELASH TINTING

CONTRA-INDICATIONS

- Eye infection or irritation - eg. Conjunctivitis.
- Open cuts and wounds.
- Is on medication eg. Roaccutane
- Spray tanning can cause a change in tint colour. Recommend that the client does not have waxing or tinting for 24 hours before and after spray tanning.
- The client is wearing contact lenses. Contact lenses must be removed when tinting eyelashes, as it is very likely that the lenses will absorb the tint and be damaged. Do not wear contact lenses for 1 few hours after eyelash tinting.
- A patch test must be performed on all new clients, before eyebrow or eyelash tinting. Best done at least 24 hours before tinting to determine if the client is sensitivity to the product. In any case, even if you have performed a patch test and there was no reaction, it is important to observe the client when they have eyebrow or eyelash tinting. If they experience substantial discomfort during the tinting process, immediately remove the tint and wash the skin thoroughly.

LYCOTIP

If you are in doubt about any of the above contra-indications; have your client check with a doctor to advise them whether it is safe for them to have an eyebrow or eyelash tint.

HOW TO PERFORM A PATCH TEST

If a client is having tinting for the first time with Lycocil Tints, a patch test must be performed at least 24 hours before tinting to determine if the client may experience an allergic reaction to the tints. Mix a small amount of tint and developer and apply a spot of tint behind the client's ear with the applicator stick and leave it on for 10 minutes. It is important to check the patch test area regularly during the 10 minutes. If there is a sign of any reaction or redness, remove the tint immediately with tepid water on a cotton pad. If the client does not experience a reaction over the next 24 hours, it is generally safe to go ahead. Advise the client to check behind their ear to see if there is any visible reaction, as they may not be able to feel it. After checking, the client needs to let you know if they have had a reaction. You will need to keep a record of it in your salon, including details of the reaction. Alternatively, the client can come in for a tint after 24 hours and you can check the patch test and make a record.

PRODUCTS USED FOR TINTING

Lycocil Tints	Blue Black - Eyelashes Black - Eyelashes & Eyebrows Grey - Eyebrows. Brown - Eyelashes & Eyebrows Light Brown - Eyebrows.
Lycocil Applicator Stick/ Tint Brushes	Applicator sticks are included with Lycocil Tints. Tint Application Brushes are available
Lycocil Peroxide	3% (10 Volume) This is the only percentage of peroxide that can be used for eyelash and eyebrow tinting.
Lycocil Protection Papers Lycocil Protective Gel	Placed under the lower eyelashes to protect the skin from the tint. Apply directly to the skin around the eyelashes and eyebrows. Also apply Lycocil Protective gel to the underside of the protection papers before they are placed under the lower lid.
Lycocil Tint Remover	Removes excess tint from the skin around the eyes and eyebrows.
Tinting Bowl	Glass or plastic - DO NOT use metal.
Cotton Pads	For removal of tint.
Cotton Buds	To apply Lycocil Protective Gel on the eyelids and around the eyebrows (anywhere you wish to protect the skin from the tint).
Gloves	To protect your hands from the tints.
Kidney Bowl	To rinse the eyes.
Cool Water	To rinse the eyes.
Milk	To rinse the eyes if there is excessive stinging.

EYEBROW TINTING PROCEDURE

PLEASE NOTE: EYELASH AND EYEBROW TINTING SHOULD ONLY BE PERFORMED BY A TRAINED PROFESSIONAL.

SELECT AN APPROPRIATE TINT COLOUR WITH YOUR CLIENT FOLLOWING THE GUIDE BELOW:

Blue Black	Best for eyelashes. Blue Black provides the most intense colour.
Black	Best for eyelashes for fair clients who are not used to wearing make-up. Also suitable for darker eyebrows.
Brown	Best for eyebrows, particularly for lighter hair clients. Black and Brown can be mixed in various amounts to create darker browns for eyelashes or eyebrows. Brown on its own is generally not dark enough on its own for eyelashes.
Light Brown	For eyebrows on very light haired people
Grey	For eyebrows on blondes or mature aged clients.

BLENDING COLOURS

All Lycocil tints can be blended to create personal colour preferences. Ensure you mix enough for both eyes.

PROCESSING TIMES

The processing times for Lycocil Tints varies depending on the depth of colour you wish to achieve. For eyelashes tints are normally left on for 8- 10 minutes. Tints only remain active for 10 minutes.

For eyebrows:

Blonde Hair	Processes very quickly - between 10 seconds to 3 minutes.
Black or Brown Hair	Takes between 5 and 10 minutes to process.
Red Hair	Tint can take 10 minutes to process, check colour at regular intervals.

NOTE: Always check how the colour is developing at regular intervals. Use a timer to remind you when the tint needs to be removed, in case you get side tracked and do not take it off soon enough.

STORAGE OF TINTS

Always replace cap after use, store in well closed containers, protect from heat and moisture, place away from direct sunlight.



Calendula has anti-inflammatory properties, which help minimise pain, swelling, bruising and sensitivity. It also contains antioxidants, that help keep the skin in good condition, making it ideally suited in depilatory wax for sensitive areas such as the face.
